RIVER FALLS HYDRO DAMS

The Kinnickinnic River Land Trust, which passed a resolution in support of a process that would consider the removal of the hydroelectric dams, is working closely with

We are all responding to the City Council and developing the information needed for the decisions it must make about the future of the hydroelectric dams on your river.

TWO SIGNIFICANT DEVELOPMENTS HAVE RECENTLY OCCURRED WHICH FURTHER THE PROCESS.

First, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, acting on an appeal of the City of River Falls, has determined to grant rehearing for further consideration of the five year license extension application filed by the City. The City is seeking the extension to undertake its planning and decision process. Congressman Ron Kind supported this request with a letter to FERC on January 26, 2016.

Second, the Friends of the Kinni, working with the River Alliance as fiscal agent, has received notice of a \$10,000.00 grant to assist in the development of the feasibility and costs which will be incurred to remove the two dams.

The grant was made by the Wisconsin DNR.


