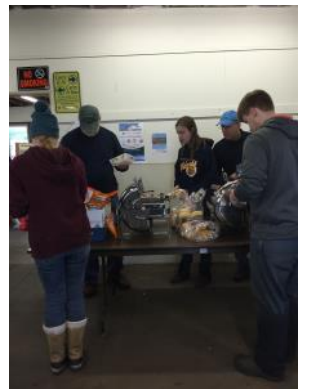


Students and parents from [Heartland Montessori](#) and [River Falls Public Montessori Elementary](#) for decorating and assembling snack bags for volunteers.

[St. Croix Valley Bird Club](#) member Cathy Olyphant for educating us about birds with her interactive board.

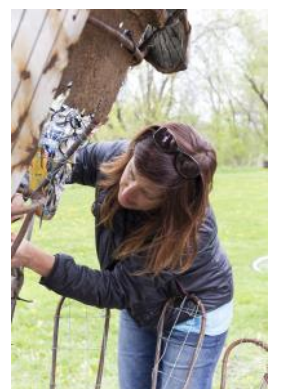
