Kinnickinnic River Land Trust continues to build our conservation and education efforts. What makes our success possible is our members who have helped grow this organization over the past thirty years. Thank you for all your support!

Land Stewardship Manager Marty Engel, the Conservation Committee, and volunteers continue efforts protecting the watershed and restoring key habitats. 100 acres were protected with a conservation easement in the spring of 2023, with another easement of 30 acres finalized in September. Our restoration and maintenance objectives are defined over the winter and then implemented each spring. For the next several years, Headwaters Preserve will be the focus of our restoration efforts to restore the landscape back into prairie and oak savanna.

Molly Barritt-Luebke continues to connect our members and community to our preserves and mission. As our Donor and Community Relations Manager, she shares our story and inspires others to help protect the Kinni. In the spring of 2022, we were able to hire UW-River Falls graduate Jane Taylor on a contract basis to help Molly enhance our social media platforms. Our need to protect the Kinni and share our story is critical as we continue to see the landscape develop around us.

A Community Conversation about Nature, Health, and Equity.

In 2022, the KRLT received a grant from The Mortenson Family Foundation for accessible trail work at Kelly Creek Preserve. When Executive Director Steve Leonard joined the organization in January of 2023, he saw a need to connect with the community to understand barriers before the trail work could begin. KRLT had an opportunity to better understand inequities and barriers to green spaces. Momentum grew, and after conversations with The Mortenson Family Foundation, the funding was adjusted to support the groundwork of focus groups and a workshop. As we continue these conversations, we look forward to sharing what we have learned and how we can make the four preserves more accessible for all.

PHENOLOGY REPORTS

My name is Jane Taylor and I write monthly Phenology reports for the Kinnickinnic River Land Trust. Phenology is the study of biological changes in relation to seasons and cycles. My reports encompass factors such as changes in weather, migration, habitat, harvest, recreation, temperature, and more! Phenology reports are important because they document the current state of the environment and allow us to compare and contrast reports from the past. I graduated from the University of Wisconsin-River Falls with a degree in Environmental Conservation, and it has been such an exciting journey to work with the KRLT to write these reports; I look forward to continuing this important work to help protect the Kinnickinnic watershed.

NEW CONSERVATION EASEMENTS

In 2023, a new conservation easement was completed in partnership with the landowner Linda Eggert. It secured the protection of over 100 acres in the headwaters of the South Fork, an important tributary of the Kinnickinnic River. This protection honored her late husband, John's dream to see their property

protected forever. The new conservation easement abuts an existing conservation easement that also consists of over 100 acres that Linda and John had put into protection in 2002. This conservation mindset has created habitat and will ensure that the headwaters of the South Fork will never be developed.

HEADWATERS PRESERVE RESTORATION

The restoration of the Headwaters Preserve is in full swing! Thanks to supporting grants from Star Prairie Fish and Game, Tropical Wings Foundation, WDNR, and the Kinnickinnic Pheasants Forever Chapter, the preserve is slowly being transitioned back to a prairie and oak savanna. The access lane was recently prepped and seeded for prairie. The removal of a large area of Box Elder Trees will make way for additional prairie plants. These native landscapes will provide critical habitat to pollinators and grassland birds. The prairie ecosystem will also be beneficial in the filtration of the headwaters of the Kinnickinnic River.

KRLT staff and board members
took part in a multi-day training
that focused on soil health. This
was part of a three-part grant in the

amount of \$10,000 from The American Farmland Trust Soil Health Award that will be used to help support conversation and handouts on the importance of soil health within the Kinnickinnic River Watershed. Stay tuned for more information and ways that you can make a difference in your own backyard.

FREE FLOWING KINNI

The Kinnickinnic River Land Trust was part of a pass-through grant from the Art and Martha Kaemmer Fun of HRK Foundation to the KinniCC that will support the costs associated with the dam removal feasibility study by the Army Corp of Engineers. We look forward to the results and are hopeful for a future with a free-flowing Kinni.
